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	<p>Need to travel out of region to perform criminal investigations.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Marathon County has a proposal for a stand-alone morgue split with County Emergency Management.• A presentation was given to the County Board in July 2016.• Sometime in September the Board will make a decision.• It was suggested that the NCW-HERC Board put together a letter of support to the Marathon County Board.• In addition a letter from each hospital in Marathon County, St Clares and Aspirus Wausau Hospitals, write a letter indicating support and that they would not be impacted financially from this endeavor.• The NCW-HERC has around \$10,000 for Ebola money for this fiscal year. There is a product for encasing the deceased. This product runs amount \$3,000 for a unit. This type of unit would be used to encase Ebola or other highly infectious disease deceased.• The NCW-HERC will have a project grant similar to last fiscal year. The total amount this year is \$81,461. The application will come out in September. The due date for the application will be 30 Nov 2016 and all applications will be reviewed during the 14 December NCW-HERC meeting.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Jim to send out when approved
